

## **Additional Expectations for the 2021 Adult Softball Season**

### **Expectations of Players & Spectators Prior to Game Play**

Prior to arrival at the field, all players and spectator that will be present at the field should acknowledge the following questions, if “yes” is answered to any of the questions, please do not attend that scheduled game.

1. Are you currently experiencing, or have you experienced COVID-19 symptoms in the past 10 days?
2. In the past 10 days, have you been in close proximity (with 6’ for 15 minutes or more), to anyone who was experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or has experienced any COVID-19 symptoms since your contact? Have you worked in an area with someone who tested positive for COVID-19?
3. In the past 10 days have you been in close proximity to anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19?
4. In the past 10 days, have you traveled outside of the United States?

We also ask that you do not attend the game as a player or spectator if you are not feeling well.

### **Expectations at the Field**

- Players should not gather in the dugout, players can also sit behind the dugout to keep within social distancing guidelines
- Players may wear masks if they desire, but they are not required to
- All spectators should keep 6 feet away from other spectators outside their household
- Umpires will not touch balls before during or after games, teams are responsible for their own game balls
- It is recommended that players bring and use their own equipment when possible
